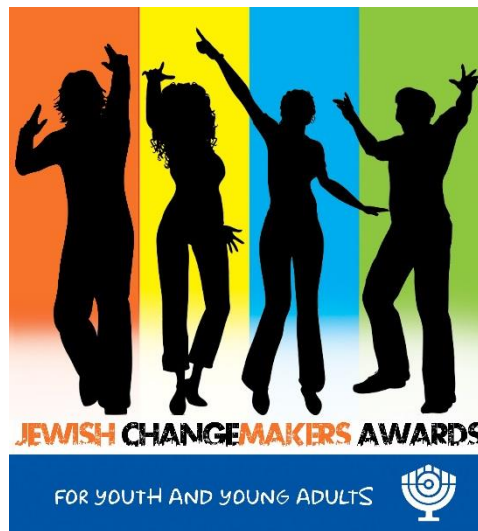




## **Jewish Change Makers Jewish Youth and Young Adult Achievement Awards Nomination Form**

## CATEGORIES

### Youth Awards – 14 -18

**1. JNF Award for Contribution to the Jewish Community: ( Youth )**

Volunteer work for an organisation – fundraising - youth movements –representing Jewish sport groups- Jewish education - promoting Jewish values, culture, tradition – entertainers – advocacy – research.

**2. Contribution to Australian Society (Youth)**

In the field of: social justice-sport – entertainment - Australian charities – Law and Order – advocacy – innovators – environmentalists - business entrepreneurs – research – intercommunity relations.

**3. Contribution to the State of Israel ( Youth )**

Volunteering, advocacy, fundraising, membership in Zionist Youth Group

### Young Adults – 18-35

**1. Contribution to Australian Society (Young Adults)**

In the field of: social justice - sport – entertainment - Australian charities – Law and Order - advocacy – innovators – environmentalists - business entrepreneurs – research – intercommunity relations.

**2. Contribution to the Jewish Community: (Young Adults )**

Volunteer work for an organisation – fundraising - youth movements –representing Jewish sport groups- Jewish education - promoting Jewish values, culture, Tradition - entertainers – advocacy – research - intercommunity relations.

**3. B'nai Brith Award for Leadership ( Young Adults )**

For exemplary leadership demonstrated by young adults in both Jewish and broader community contexts. Awarded to an individual who has demonstrated vision, initiative and the capacity to inspire those around him/her, and exhibits pride in their Jewish identity.

**4. Contribution to the State of Israel ( Young Adults )**

Fundraising, volunteering, advocacy also via Zionist organisations.

**5. Educator of the Year Award (Young Adults )**

A Volunteer, or someone who does extra unpaid work – being a teacher, a Rabbi, a Youth Leader, going above and beyond their normal call of duty.

- i. A correctly and legibly completed application form must be received by Friday **27 May 2016**. All applications (and any accompanying materials) become the property of the organisers, once received, and may be utilised for promotional purposes.
- ii. Applications will only be accepted for young adults aged 18-35 and youth 14 – 18.
- iii. Submission of an application shall be deemed as acceptance of all terms and conditions, and no responsibility shall be accepted for late, lost, incomplete or illegible applications.
- iv. The organisers may, at their sole discretion, extend, vary or terminate the award competition or any of its rules, terms and conditions, at any time without notice, and shall not be liable in relation to any reliance placed thereon, prior to such variation or termination.
- v. The winner will be announced on Sunday 19 June 2016. However, the organisers reserve the right not to determine a winner of the award, if in their opinion, there is no entry or insufficient entries which satisfy the judge's criteria. All judgments are final and no correspondence shall be entered into in this regard.
- vi. Applicants release and hold harmless the judges and organisers (and their officers/agents) from any and all liability for any loss or damage of any kind arising from or in connection with the competition or any awards given.
