26th ANNUAL JEWISH YOUTH ART COMPETITION 2021

Conditions of Entry

1. Categories of Works

The Competition is open for original works of artists in the following categories:

- a) **Paintings** - including Watercolours, Acrylics, Oils, Pastels, Charcoal, Ink, Pencil etc.
- b) **Sculpture** - including a variety of media displayed as free-standing artworks.
- c) **Mixed Media** - including Wall Hangings, Collages and other Graphic arts which do not fall into either of the above-mentioned categories.
- d) **Digital – for ages 16-18 only.**
- e) **Photography – for ages 16-18 only.**

Prizes in all categories plus: (i) The Morrie Gold Memorial Award, (ii) Outstanding work on a Jewish theme in any medium, (iii) The Thalia Hakin Memorial Prize, and (iv) The Peter Krafel Memorial Prize in Photography

2. Age Categories: 11 to 13 years; 14 to 15 years; 16 to 18 years.

3. Eligibility

- a) Entrants must be of the Jewish faith, and must not be older than 18 years or younger than 11 years on the 1st of May, 2021.
- b) All works must have been completed after 30th April 2020.
- c) All works must be the original work of the entrant.

4. Entry Registration

All entrants to the Competition must register via the online **BBVic Art Competition Registration** system (accessible via the B'nai B'rith Victoria website) **no later than Thursday 18th June 2021.**

5. Submission of Works

- a) Physical delivery of artworks at the Glen Eira Council gallery (Corner Glen Eira and Hawthorn Roads, Caulfield) is required on Sunday 19th July between 1:00 PM and no later than 5:30 PM.
- b) Please note that late entries will not be accepted.

6. B'nai B'rith reserves the right to refuse acceptance of any entry or work.

7. Display of Works

The Official Opening and Presentation of Awards will take place on Sunday 25th July 2021 at 2:00 pm.

8. The Organisers will not enter into discussion, either verbally or in writing, on any judgement. All works must remain on display for the duration of the Exhibition.

9. The Organisers have the right to use photographs of the artworks for publicity purposes.

10. The Organisers reserve the right to withhold any prize if the work/works are below considered standards.

11. Each prize winner will be required to nominate, via a simple online application, whether their prize is a cheque or voucher and how they would like it to be delivered (e.g., funds transfer to nominated bank account, cheque, post to nominated address or collection from the BBVic office).
