## Message from the President...on strengthening Jewish life



I recently approved the go-ahead of changing the tag-line of B'nai B'rith Victoria on the wall of our office in Beth Weizmann. The previous one was "Jewish unity, diversity and continuity". This seemed quite reasonable, except that when I asked people about the motto, they could either not remember the correct order, or they only recalled two out of three items, or they weren't sure what all of the words meant in this context. So, as good as it theoretically might have been, the Exec and I thought we should go with something that was easier to remember and hopefully easier to understand. Some time ago, we came up with "Strengthening Jewish life". This phrase recognises that B'nai B'rith's core business is to support people like you to 'give back' to the Jewish community by working together via projects, programs, events and partnerships. We create opportunities for you to do this in a way that also satisfies your desire for a more meaningful Jewish identity. B'nai B'rith caters for those of you who appreciate Jewish social cohesion and wish to engage in activities that support it. By doing so, you strengthen your own Jewish life and also that of your friends and colleagues.

Some of you know that I run a Jewish-themed Non-Fiction Book Club. The July session presented a book by Micah Goodman titled *The Wondering Jew*. Although it was mainly focussed on how Jews self-identify in Israel, much of the analysis can be applied to the Diaspora. The book referred to two principal ways of identifying: the religious and the secular. Goodman explained that the difference is not always a strict dichotomy; there is a large group 'in between' which we would call traditional. These are people who take a bit from religion, especially its practice rather than its belief, and another bit from a sense of peoplehood, which is a more ethno-national or cultural perspective.

Melbourne, like all Diaspora communities, is challenged to preserve Jewish life in the long run. Assimilation, particularly for the less religious, remains an ongoing threat. That is why we should be so invested in a community organisation such as B'nai B'rith whose fundamental purpose is to strengthen our participation in and belonging to a community – and to do so 'Jewishly'.

B'nai B'rith is a very inclusive organisation and caters for the religious, the secular and the in-between traditionalists. The minimum requirement that inspires B'nai B'rith is that in working together for the good of our community, we should also help to strengthen Jewish life. Simply donating to a charity will not do it. Going to an interesting talk as an individual won't do it. Attending a restaurant or a movie with fellow Jews does not really achieve it either. However, coming together and working together on a range of activities including helping those in need, supporting human rights and fostering education, celebrating our achievers and advocating for Israel – these can assist us in our goal of social cohesion and continuity.

So, when they ask you next, 'What does B'nai B'rith stand for?', you can tell them: B'nai B'rith works to strengthen Jewish life.

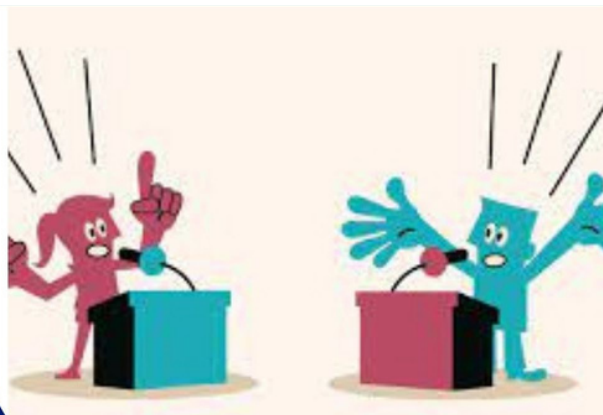

As part of NAIDOC Week 'For Our Elders', the Yoorrook Truth & Justice Commission yesterday organised an Open Day of their new Collingwood premises.

Jack Aghion, Chair of the B'nai B'rith First Nations Reconciliation Project and his wife Eleanor, were invited to attend where they met Uncle Kevin Coombs OAM, 82 year old ex Australian Basketball Paralympic Champion. There they also met Professor Eleanor Bourke AM the Yoorrook Commissioner.

One aspect that we found incredible is that when Uncle Kevin as a young athlete went to London to represent Australia, he had to travel on a temporary British Passport, as this was prior to the Referendum of 1967 when Aboriginal people were finally counted as Australians.

The Commission has been set up to record the stories of the Elders of the community, before that information and knowledge is lost forever to time.

It was a privilege to have been invited to their Open Day. It happened to coincide with the day when our Prime Minister, publicly acknowledged the work of B'nai B'rith and the Jewish community, towards Reconciliation.
